

DARK NIGHT SAFETY FOR CATS

With longer nights during autumn and winter, the risk of your cat getting lost or injured increases. Check out our top tips to keep them safe at night.

Road Safety Tips:

- 1 Use a reflective collar to make your cat more visible to drivers at night.
- 2 Microchipping is required by law and helps in reuniting lost cats.
- 3 Check your car's wheels for cats seeking warmth before driving.

Encourage Your Cat to Stay Home:

- 4 Serve meals earlier to bring your cat indoors before dark.
- 5 Rotate toys to make staying inside more fun after dark.
- 6 Provide litter trays inside to reduce outdoor trips at night.
- 7 Offer warm bedding inside and an outdoor shelter to keep your cat closer to home on chilly nights.
